

Call for Return Mission Proposals

EEFIT is seeking proposals for return missions to further capture lessons from past earthquake events where EEFIT carried out a mission in the past.

This application form is to be typed and emailed as a PDF file eefit@istructe.org by **17:00 Wednesday 15 January 2020**.

Applications must be submitted according to the instructions and funding criteria given below otherwise they may be disqualified:

- Funding is available for travel costs for two academics and two PhD students per mission
- Funds will also cover mission equipment costs

Eligible applicants:

- UK academics including Research Associates and PhD students registered at a UK university who are not already funded by UK research councils are eligible.

Ineligible applicants:

- Academics with current funding from UK research councils (research grants or studentships) are ineligible for funding.

The following criteria will be used to judge proposals:

- Impact of the proposed return mission in line with EEFIT's wider objectives
- Clear objectives for the mission
- Qualifications and experience of the nominated team leader
- The proposal demonstrates engagement and collaboration with local stakeholders

Note: Match-funds can include potential support from industry partners to fund other team members
